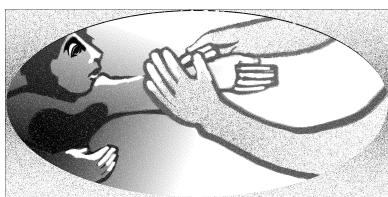

BISHOP ROBERT CHRISTIAN IS SEMINARY RECTOR-PRESIDENT

The Archdiocese of San Francisco announced on January 14th that the Most Rev. Robert F. Christian, O.P., Auxiliary Bishop of San Francisco, has been appointed Rector-President of St. Patrick Seminary. Archbishop Cordileone said, "I am excited that Bishop Christian, a man of deep love for the Church and extensive academic achievement, will be leading the seminary during its next phase of development and growth." Bishop Christian, ordained a bishop for San Francisco in June 2018, has held teaching and administrative positions at the Pontifical University of St. Thomas Aquinas (the Angelicum) in Rome for many years, and from 1997 to 1999 was vicar provincial of the Western Dominican Province headquartered in Oakland.
