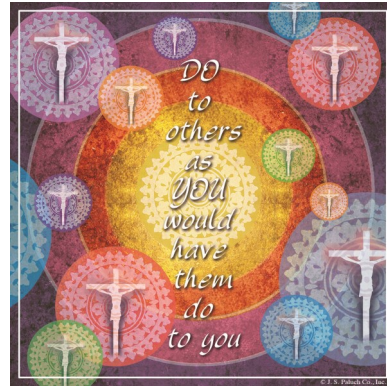

RELIC OF ST. JOHN VIANNEY

The Knights of Columbus is sponsoring a major relic pilgrimage of the incorrupt heart of St. John Vianney, the famed "Curé of Ars" (1786–1859), who is the patron saint of parish priests. The relic is on loan from the Shrine at Ars (in France), where the saint's incorrupt body, including the heart, is normally on display. The shrine welcomes more than half a million visitors each year. The public is welcome to venerate the relic in the Archdiocese at these dates and times:

MOSAIC TV: THE ORDER OF PREACHERS

The priests, brothers, and sisters who wear the initials O.P. after their names, for Ordinis Praedicatorum, have been in service and in leadership in the Archdiocese of San Francisco from the very beginning: The Dominicans' western province was founded in 1850, and when this Archdiocese was created in 1853, it was Joseph Alemany, O.P., who was named Archbishop. On the **March 3rd** episode of Mosaic, two Dominican friars, Fr. Michael Hurley (pastor of St. Dominic Parish in San Francisco) and Fr. James Moore (Vicar for Advancement for the Western Province) discuss their order's mission and history, the challenges and opportunities in preaching the Gospel to a postmodern culture, and the robust success of the Order of Preachers here in the west, both in religious vocations and in parish life. DAY OF VENERATION: OUR LADY OF FATIMA

The Carmelite Sisters in San Rafael welcome all to a day-long veneration of the **Statue of Our Lady of Fatima** on **Tuesday, March 5th**. The statue arrives and set-up is done at 10:00 am; veneration can begin immediately.
