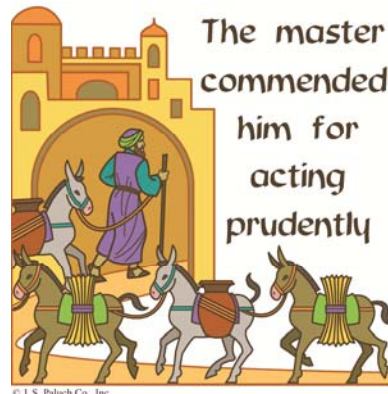

PRIESTS' RETIREMENT FUND

There are two opportunities in the coming weeks to help support the Archdiocese's retired priests:

MOSAIC TV: MARY & THE ROSARY RALLY

The Archdiocese of San Francisco has at its heart a special place for our Mother Mary, and the Rosary is a form of prayer specially connected with her. In 1961, San Francisco was the site of a rally at which half a million people gathered in Golden Gate Park to pray the Rosary with Fr. Patrick Peyton. The Rosary Rally tradition was revived in 2011, and on October 5, 2019, Archbishop Cordileone will celebrate Mass in St. Mary’s Cathedral and lead a procession to UN Plaza for prayer, preaching, and Benediction. On the **Sunday, September 29th** edition of Mosaic, Raymond Frost (of the Legion of Mary) and Deacon R.
