

ATTENTION: Indoor gatherings are not currently permitted under the San Francisco County Public Health Order. For this reason, all churches in San Francisco have been asked to suspend public Masses indoors. Until further notice, all scheduled weekday and weekend masses at Church of the Visitacion will be closed to the public. We will be returning to the livestream schedule that was in place at the start of the pandemic (see below). Only those people necessary to serve the Mass and livestream it will be allowed to attend (no more than 12). Obligation to attend Sunday Mass remains under Dispensation until restrictions and limitations are lifted. But you must keep the Lord's Day holy in other ways, at home.

IMAGINING GOD'S ABUNDANCE

When reflecting upon today's Gospel passage from Matthew, the story of the feeding of the multitude, we might consider the role of Jesus' disciples. Unlike the very similar story in Matthew 15, Jesus responds to the disciples by saying, "Give them some food yourselves." Jesus is pushing his disciples to think beyond the apparent scarcity, and to open their imaginations to God's abundance. They are to join in with what God is doing. Jesus then takes, blesses, breaks, and shares the bread (anticipating his action at the Last Supper), and the disciples share the loaves with the crowd.

The stories of the feeding of the multitudes also point ahead to the practice of Eucharist in the Church. The Eucharist itself points ahead to God's banquet at the consummation of the reign of God, when all will share God's abundance. We the Church are called to open our imaginations to God present and active, who continually works toward God's promised future. We are to share in God's passionate desire to feed the people, and join in what God is doing here and now.

SEMINARY CANCELS ANNUAL GALA

St. Patrick's Seminary and University (STPSU) has announced that its Annual Gala fundraiser, scheduled for September 12, will be canceled due to COVID-19. STPSU reports that despite the challenges of the pandemic, the seminarians were able to successfully complete their studies remotely for the past term. Seven seminarians graduated in June 2020. And on August 1, 2020, two men, Ian Quito and Benjamin Rosado, will be ordained by Archbishop Cordileone as priests for the archdiocese.

STPSU's administration in their statement about the Gala said, "Such a large gathering, typically 600-700 people, does not seem appropriate or prudent at this time despite its critical role in generating much needed financial support for our mission. We anticipate resuming the Annual Gala in September 2021. Please help us by donating online what you would have spent at our 2020 Annual Gala." ARCHBISHOP'S STATEMENTS AND OP-EDS ON HISTORICAL MEMORY AND ACCURACY

In recent weeks Archbishop Cordileone has emerged as a popular spokesperson on the topic of historical monuments, as a national conversation on this is taking place. Initially responding to the destruction of the statue of St. Junipero Serra in Golden Gate Park, he continues to encourage consideration of how we regard historical figures in the larger context, and of how we ourselves and our current leaders may be viewed by future generations. Recently the San Francisco Chronicle published his op-ed on the renaming of major league sports teams such as the Washington Redskins, in which the Archbishop posits that the 49ers may be the next to come under criticism. Many people, including faithful Catholics, have not studied this local saint beyond doing fourth grade mission projects.
