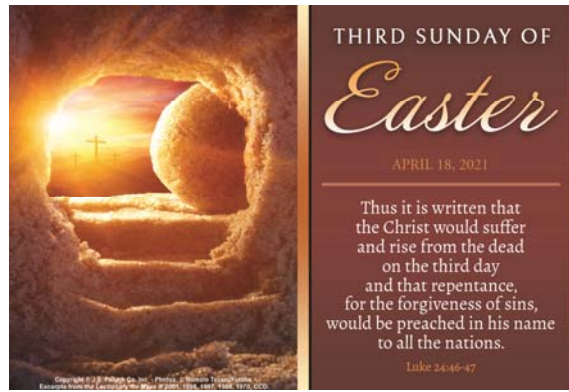

NOT WHAT WAS EXPECTED

Have you ever waited for something for so long you began to think it might never happen? Your graduation day, or the day of your marriage, or the birth of a child, perhaps. The Israelites had waited for centuries for the coming of the Messiah. Yet when Jesus, the long-awaited Anointed One came, many failed to believe in him. He wasn't what they expected. The Messiah was supposed to be a strong, powerful commander of armies, not humble, compassionate, and suffering. After his resurrection, Jesus appeared to the disciples and explained all that he had said in his time with them, opening their minds to what had been written in the scriptures so that they could accept his suffering and death and rejoice in his resurrection.

**THOMAS MERTON'S EPIPHANIES:
A SPIRITUAL JOURNEY IN THREE ACTS**

Thomas Merton is one of the towering figures of contemplative spirituality over the last century. This Trappist monk was a gifted writer and a brilliant interpreter of the Christian spiritual tradition, making the case for how contemplative spirituality remains relevant — and not just for monks and nuns. This day of reflection will focus on three key "epiphanies" or moments of profound spiritual encounter in Merton's life — at a Catholic Mass in Cuba in 1940; on a busy urban street corner in 1958; and at a Sri Lankan Buddhist temple in 1968 (days before Merton's death at the age of 53). Each of these events offers a different window into the spirituality and mystical genius of Merton, and how his insights can inspire us today.

This retreat will be held virtually on **Saturday, April 24th** and will be led by Lay Trappist and author Carl McColman. Sessions are from 10:00am-12:00pm and 2:00-4:00pm; attend one or both sessions. Cost is \$20. A recording will be made available for ticket holders. Register at www.eventbrite.com/e/129104696623.
