

THE CALL AND CAUSE OF LOVE

Love calls and causes us to do great things, more than we might believe we are capable of. While some are called to give their lives as martyrs, most of us find ourselves called to lay down our lives in smaller ways in the midst of everyday life. Parents lose sleep in the early moments of their baby's life, and again as their teens mature and gain independence. Adult children change their plans to care for aging parents. We hear the call of love as we become attentive and respond to the needs of the poor, lonely, sick, and vulnerable. Love causes us to turn our lives around, to strive to become more Christ-like in our words and actions. Peter followed this call of love when he entered the house of Cornelius, a Gentile. He was likely as astounded at the outpouring of the Holy Spirit as were the believers who accompanied him, yet love caused Peter to see beyond the accepted boundaries of religion and race, seeing instead evidence of the Lord's great love at work.


ARCHBISHOP RELEASES PASTORAL LETTER

At the Archdiocesan monthly pro-life Mass in St. Mary's Cathedral on Saturday, May 1st, Archbishop Cordileone announced the release of the first pastoral letter of his episcopacy. Titled "Before I Formed You in the Womb I Knew You," the letter focuses on the dignity of the unborn, the reception of Holy Communion, and the responsibilities of Catholics in public life. In the Q&A that accompanied the letter, Archbishop Cordileone said he wrote it because he felt the need to "make a clear statement of the moral gravity of abortion and the basic principles that should guide Catholics, both private citizens and those who have a role in public life."

The full letter is available to read at InTheWomb.org. Also at that location are explanatory resources, including the Q&A and an Executive Summary, and an opportunity to subscribe to receive notice of upcoming related events. All documents are available in Spanish and Chinese. Pro-life Masses are held on the first Saturday of each month at 8:00 am in St. Mary's Cathedral. All are welcome.
