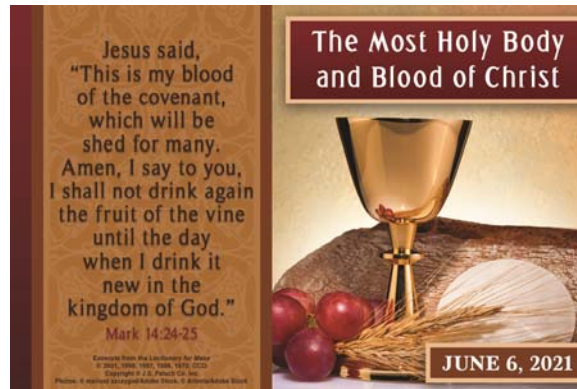

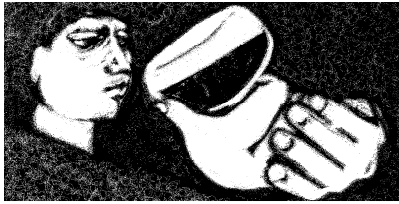

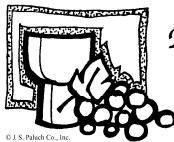

ROSARY RALLY FOR THE SACRED HEART

June is the month of the Sacred Heart. Join the Legion of Mary for a **Rosary Rally** in honor of the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus on **Saturday, June 12th** after the 7:30 a.m. morning Mass. All are welcome. No matter our troubles, whether personal or societal, we can always turn to the Sacred Heart of Jesus for solace and entrust our worries and problems to Our Lord, since all things are possible with God.

JESUS' SACRIFICE AND OURS

In presenting the still-familiar four-fold “Shape of the Eucharist”—Jesus takes / blesses / breaks / gives (Mark 14:22)—Mark omits Matthew’s specification of purpose “for the forgiveness of sins,” and Luke’s “for the remembrance of me.” But Jesus does recall the covenant, Israel’s liberation from Egypt’s slavery. And could the disciples—or we—fail to recall that, in Mark’s earliest verses, Jesus sits at table “with tax collectors and those known as sinners” (2:15)? Mark also emphasizes the Eucharist as our participation in Jesus’ passion and pledge of our share in his future glory. Jesus had earlier referred to his disciples’ suffering as “drinking from the cup he would drink” (10:38-39). Soon he would beg his Abba to “take this cup away” (14:36). But while sharing the Eucharistic cup, Jesus promises a day when he would “drink it new” (14:25): the cup of suffering and sorrow is not the last cup he—or we—will drink, the cup of the Garden of Agony will be transformed into the cup of the Kingdom of God.

STOP THE REMOVAL OF SAFEGUARDS ON PHYSICIAN-ASSISTED SUICIDE

Action Alert to prevent Physician-Assisted Suicide Proponents to Remove “Safeguards” — This legislation will weaken patient protections in the already existing assisted suicide law. The move follows the usual path of physician-assisted suicide laws in other states and nations – promise protections and limits, then gradually strip those away. Specifically, SB 380 (Eggman, D-Stockton) would:

- Prematurely end the existing 2025 sunset date and legislative reevaluation option years early with little to no scientific data to support this action (especially in light of the worldwide pandemic);
- Stop future oversight or evaluation of annual reports about assisted suicide requests and their outcomes. (Existing reports do not contain any data regarding complications, reasons for requesting the lethal drugs, and for the limited data provided, much is listed as “unknown”)
- Remove the 15-day waiting period “safeguard”

The Pastoral Ministry Online School is pleased to announce our next offering: Dr. Peter Kreeft Presents Catholicism and the Lord of the Rings!

The Lord of the Rings was voted "the greatest book of the (20th) century" by four popular polls. It is uniquely, but anonymously, Catholic, by Tolkien's own description of it. We will share Frodo's dramatic journey (which is symbolically our journey too) at a leisurely pace, one book out of the six for each class, and discover many hidden treasures of wisdom along the way. Dr. Peter Kreeft says, "from my experience in teaching a course on Tolkien every two or three years at Boston College, I think it works best by simply following the plot of *The Lord of the Rings* through its six books in six weeks, one week for each book. Rereading *The Lord of the Rings* is something nearly everyone who reads it once wants to do anyway. My book *The Philosophy of Tolkien* is recommended as a guide, especially since it uses Tolkien's own letters to interpret his book; but it is not required or presupposed."
